In 2002, an orca calf was discovered swimming alone in Puget Sound. This compelling nonfiction story follows the team of scientists who worked together against all odds to save Springer from starvation and reunite her with her family.

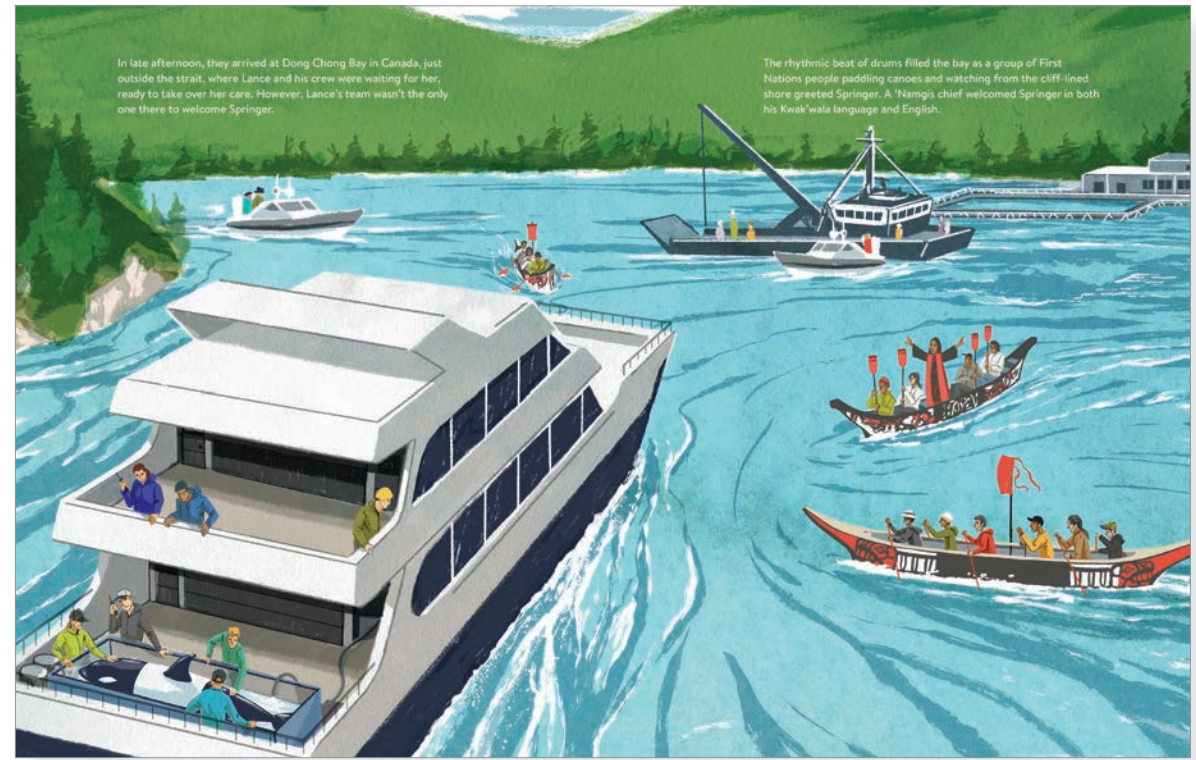
The challenges of capturing Springer, transporting her north from Puget Sound to Canadian waters, and coordinating her release, where they hope she will be accepted back into her family, are brought to life in beautiful illustrations that will appeal to readers of all ages.

This is a hopeful and celebratory conservation story with a happy ending: Springer gave birth to her first calf, Spirit, in 2013, and a second calf, Storm, in 2017.

In late afternoon, they arrived at Dong Chong Bay in Canada, just outside the strait, where Lance and his crew were waiting for her, ready to take over her care. However, Lance's team wasn't the only one there to welcome Springer.

The rhythmic beat of drums filled the bay as a group of First Nations people paddling canoes and watching from the cliff-lined shore greeted Springer. A 'Namgis chief welcomed Springer in both his Kwak'waka language and English.



Winter blew into the Pacific Northwest, cold and wet, and the rainy months trickled by. The scientists wondered and worried about Springer. Was she being fully accepted into her family? Would she still be with the pods when they returned to the Johnstone Strait? Only time would tell.

In February 2003, a group of thirty orcas swam into the waters of the Queen Charlotte Strait, just north of the Johnstone Strait. The incoming report said that Nodales was with them, but to Dr. Dave and Lance's disappointment, not Springer.

As spring bloomed into summer, more orcas returned to the Johnstone Strait area, but there was still no sign of Springer.

Then, on July 9, 2003, nearly one year after her release, Springer swam through the Queen Charlotte Strait with Nahwititi and Nahwititi's mother, Yakat.

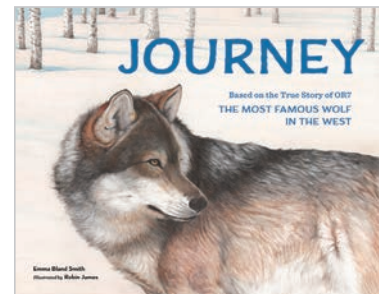
Springer had fattened up over the winter. How happy and healthy she looked to have found a family at last!

Springer's rescue and release was a success. Everyone was elated. She had touched so many hearts.

Lance marveled at the orcas' strong sense of community, amazed that the pod had welcomed Springer back.

For Dr. Dave, Springer would forever remain his most special patient and her release his greatest success story.

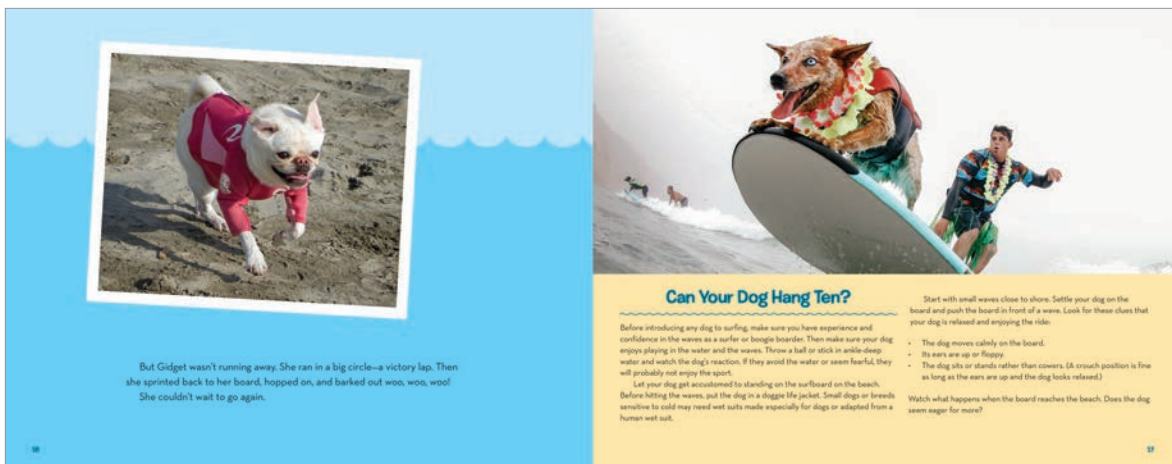

Catching Waves with a Small but Mighty Pug

This is the inspiring true story of Gidget, a world-champion surfing pug, who grew from a hyperactive handful of a pup to a poised and impressive surfer whose efforts are devoted to charity. As she and her owner, Alecia, find their way through challenges including a life-threatening illness, Gidget's story becomes not only about a dog learning to surf and compete in dog surfing competitions but also about making the most of the life you are given and giving back to your community. Filled with entertaining and informative science sidebars, *Gidget the Surfing Dog* will teach kids about waves and other aspects of the science of surfing.



But Gidget wasn't running away. She ran in a big circle—a victory lap. Then she sprinted back to her board, hopped on, and barked out woo, woo, woo! She couldn't wait to go again.

Can Your Dog Hang Ten?

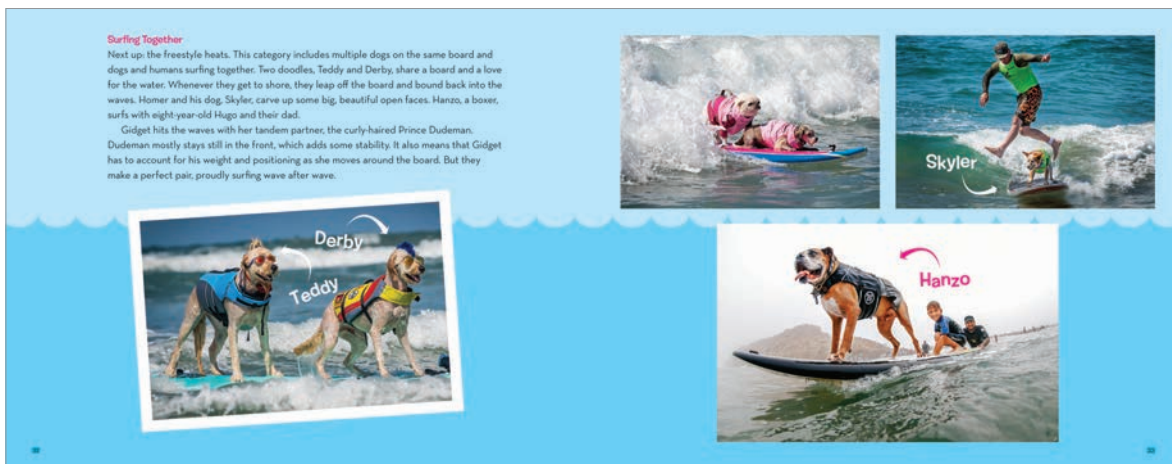
Before introducing any dog to surfing, make sure you have experience and confidence in the waves as a surfer or longboarder. Then make sure your dog enjoys playing in the water and the waves. Throw a ball or stick in shallow water and watch the dog's reaction. If they avoid the water or seem fearful, they will probably not enjoy the sport.

Let your dog get accustomed to standing on the surfboard on the beach. Before hitting the waves, put the dog in a doggie life jacket. Small dogs or breeds sensitive to cold may need wet suits made especially for dogs or adapted from a human wet suit.

Start with small waves close to shore. Settle your dog on the board and push the board in front of a wave. Look for these clues that your dog is relaxed and enjoying the ride:

- The dog moves calmly on the board.
- Its ears are up or floppy.
- The dog sits or stands rather than cowers. (A crouch position is fine as long as the ears are up and the dog looks relaxed.)

Watch what happens when the board reaches the beach. Does the dog seem eager for more?



Surfing Together

Next up: the freestyle heats. This category includes multiple dogs on the same board and dogs and humans surfing together. Two doodles, Teddy and Derby, share a board and a love for the water. Whenever they get to shore, they leap off the board and bound back into the waves. Homer and his dog, Skyler, carve up some big, beautiful open faces. Hanzo, a boxer, surfs with eight-year-old Hugo and their dad.

Gidget hits the waves with her tandem partner, the curly-haired Prince Dudeman. Dudeman mostly stays still in the front, which adds some stability. It also means that Gidget has to account for his weight and positioning as she moves around the board. But they make a perfect pair, proudly surfing wave after wave.
