He is the host of four recent PBS series, Making North America, The Great Yellowstone Thaw, Polar Extremes, and Ice Age Footprints. He has written ten books including Prehistoric Journey, Cruisin' The Fossil Freeway, Digging Snowmastodon, Cruisin' the Fossil Coastline, and Ancient Wyoming.
