Why do you get facial hair? When does it grow?

The same horrznome that makes us grow taller, get bigger muscles, and have lower voices (*Relfold@come*) also makes hair grow during puberty in certain places it never grew before. Your **Faccial hair** starts to grow when puberty begins but it doesn't come in fully until much later—for some guys, not until their twenties! Some guys will grow hair early, while some will grow it later; some guys will wild up having a lot, while others won't have as much; some will have dark hair, while some will have very light hair. A lot of these differences depend on what you inherit from your birth parents, so you'll probably end up looking a lot like the wen in gour famely.

Does SHAVING affect hair growth anywhere (not just your face)?

Although lots of boys might think that shaving speeds up hair growth, that's a **myth**. Shaving hair makes no difference in how fast it's going to grow back—whether that's on your head, your face, or anywhere else. *Hair is on its own schedale*.

I read in a book that if you have sex standing up you don't get pregnant. Is that true?

You can **get pregnant** standing, sitting, or lying down. You can get pregnant having sex in a bed, in a car, or on a couch. You can get pregnant if a penis and a vagina are *close exough to touch*.

Can you get pregnant other ways besides sexual intercourse? (I've heard sitting on a toilet seat?)

You cannot get pregnant from sitting on a toilet seat, touching a doorknob, shaking hands, or kissing. *You Cannot get pregnant anbua* a penis gets **close** to a vagina. Sometimes there is **Sperm** present in fluid on the tip of a penis, and if that touches a woman's vulwa@wbf.*for a 4000d*, it's possible that sperm would use the fluid available in the vagina to swim inside the woman.

If a penis has a CONDOM for sexual intercourse, what's the point of putting the penis inside the vagina because it can't do anything?

Just because a penis has a condom on it doesn't mean that it can't do anything. A condom will help **prevent** sperm from going into the vagina and **reduce the risk** of sharing a sexually transmitted infection and starting a pregnancy. It still allows a penis to claculate sperm, and the resulting organm is very **pleasurable**.

Will your beard grow your hair color? Usually. Sometimes it can be a little lighter or darker, and when you get old, it can turn gray earlier or later than the rest of your hair. The color has a lot to do with your family and what color hair you inherind from your birth mom and birth dad. Oh, and the hair d your beard *wight feel a little different* from the hair on your head.

How do you grow a GOATEE?

Easy! You **shave** away everything that isn't a goatee! The good thing is, if you don't like what you see, you can always let it **grow out** or shave it off.

When will I have to begin shaving?

Many boys will see *some soft hair growing* above their **upper lips** early in puberty. You can start shaving as soon as you have hair to shave. One of the cool things about facial hair is that you can **decide** what you want it to look like ... and change your mind. Do you want a clean-shaven face, or do you want a long **beard**? Or maybe a **mustache** you can twist around your ears?! You can try something out, like a soul patch, then shave it off if you don't want it anymore.
