Central Park, New York
May 21, 1944*

I often wonder whether we do not rest our hopes too much upon constitutions, upon laws, and upon courts. These are false hopes; believe me, these are false hopes. Liberty lies in the hearts of men and women; when it dies there, no constitution, no law, no court can even do much to help it. While it lies there it needs no constitution, no law, no court to save it. . . . What then is the spirit of liberty? I cannot define it; I can only tell you my own faith. The spirit of liberty is the spirit which is not too sure that it is right; the spirit of liberty is the spirit which seeks to understand the mind of other men and women; the spirit of liberty is the spirit which weighs their interests alongside its own without bias; the spirit of liberty remembers that not even a sparrow falls to earth unheeded; . . . that there may be a kingdom where the least shall be heard and considered side by side with the greatest.

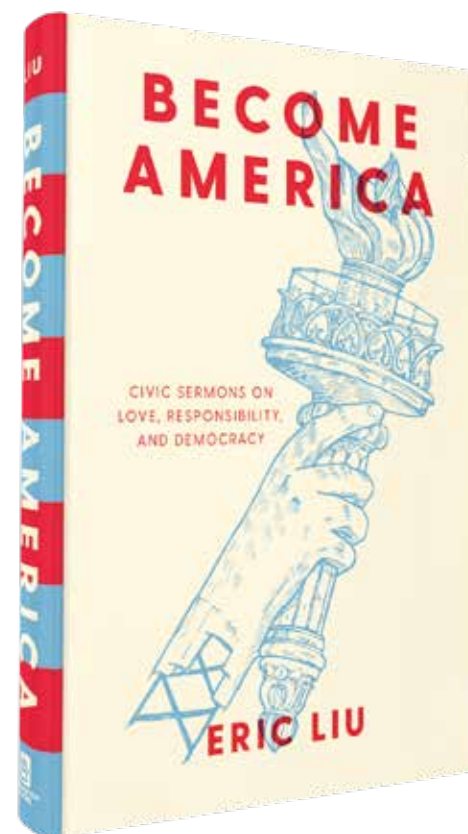

A US Soldier's Secret and Heroic Role in World War II

This remarkable, little-known slice of history about a Japanese American who served in a top-secret team in World War II reveals how the confluence of race, war, and loyalty played out when our nation called for the service of those it judged most harshly.

Born in southern California but educated as a teenager in Japan during the 1930s, Masao Abe returned to the US and was drafted into the US Army. As he completed basic training, the attack on Pearl Harbor put his military career in limbo because the US government didn't know what to do with him—was he an enemy or a patriot? Eventually recruited to join the secretive Military Intelligence Service, he was trained to accompany American soldiers as they fought their way across the islands in the Pacific. His assignment: Convince soldiers of the Imperial Japanese Army to lay down their arms. Masao went to war with a bodyguard because his commanders knew he wore a target on both his front *and* back. This amazing untold story of World War II still feels highly relevant in today's political climate.
